GROWING HOPE GLOBALLY UPDATE

Ten acres of ground in Boonville, Mo, volunteers, and God's blessings combined for a joint effort to raise a soybean crop. The crop was sold, and the proceeds will help families in food insecure areas improve their farming techniques, seeds, etc.

This year's project raised \$5,000 bringing our twenty-oneyear total to \$134,690.93. It was supported by Rhea Helmerich (land), Boonville Co-Op (chemicals), MFA (fertilizer), Joe Miller (seed), Eddie Wassmann & Kenny Stegner (farming). Thank you to all!!

Program Summary - Nicaragua Carazo Diriamba

A dry climate, environmental deterioration, and chronic poverty have contributed to an inadequate quantity and quality of water and insufficient food in this region, resulting in malnutrition and other health problems. These challenges are complicated by illiteracy, poor roads, high unemployment, and seasonal migration to Costa Rica. 55 percent of households in the area are headed by women. Since 2005, local partner CIEETS has been working to reach the most food insecure families in Nicaragua. The current phase of their work reaches out to a third group of communities after two previous successful programs. They are working on conservation agriculture, planting fruit trees and patio gardens, gaining access to clean water, community advocacy, and coordinating with churches to be active in programs that build food security.

HEALTH FACTS Breast Cancer Screening

Breast cancer is the second-leading cause of cancer deaths in women and now younger women (less than 50 years of age) have a 1 in 50 risk for developing invasive breast cancer.

Regular breast screenings should start at age 40. Some risk factors or family history may warrant earlier screenings.

The standard 3D mammogram is the preferred imaging. Women should also feel for hard lumps which don't move easily.

Is there an age women can stop getting mammograms? It's a discussion that you should have with your health care provider. Your age, state of health, and family history are factors to consider.
